	Application form for a type D entry visa.
	Recent passport-sized photograph, according to the instructions provided in the following link https://www.icao.int/sites/default/files/FAL/Annex_A-Photograph_Guidelines.pdf .
	Valid travel document with an expiration date at least three months later than that of the requested visa.
	Medical-health documentation including: a) medical documentation issued in the country of residence attesting to actual infirmity; b) a declaration from the Italian public or private healthcare facility (the latter must be accredited by the National Health Service) indicating the type of treatment, start date, duration, and presumed cost; c) an attestation from the Italian healthcare facility confirming the deposit of at least 30% of the presumable cost of the requested service, or, alternatively, specific regional resolution or even specific authorization issued by the Ministry of Health as part of humanitarian programs.
	Documentation proving the availability in Italy of sufficient resources for the payment of the remainder of health costs, room and board outside the health facility, and for the repatriation of the patient and any accompanying person.
	For any companions of the sick person, health insurance, having a minimum coverage of €30,000, covering the costs necessary for emergency hospitalization and repatriation costs.
	Round-trip reservation/ticket or demonstration of the availability of personal means of transport, including any accompanying person.
