	A valid travel document with an expiry date at least three months later than that of the visa applied for.
	A certificate confirming the availability of the necessary resources for the entrepreneurial, commercial or craft activity to be undertaken, issued by the Chamber of Commerce with jurisdiction over the territory where the activity will be carried out. These resources must not be less than three times the annual social allowance.
	Sufficient financial means in Italy to guarantee the amount of resources required as stated in the Certificate.
	Availability of an income – relating to the previous financial year – exceeding the minimum level required by law for exemption from healthcare contributions (€8,500), already earned in the country of residence.
	Nulla Osta (Authorisation) from the local police headquarters ( <i>Questura</i> ).
	Availability of suitable accommodation.
	Health insurance with a minimum cover of €30,000, covering the costs of emergency hospitalisation and repatriation
