	Valid travel document with an expiration date at least three months later than that of the requested visa.
	Round-trip reservation/ticket.
	Registration documentation of the vocational training course you intend to attend (with indication of duration, program, certification acquired, etc.). The course must be organized by training institutions that have obtained accreditation to manage professional training courses (pursuant to art. 142, paragraph 1, letter d, DL 112/1998; Ministerial Decree Ministry of Labor No. 166 of 05/25/2001). The course may not last longer than 24 months and must be aimed at the recognition of a qualification or, in any case, the certification of the skills acquired.
	Documentation relating to training acquired in the country of origin.
	Demonstration of the availability of means of support in relation to the stay in Italy, for an amount not less than that established by Table A annexed to the Directive of the Ministry of the Interior of 1.3.2000 ( <a href="https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/files/public/moduli/it/Direttiva_MinInterno_1-3-2000.pdf">https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/files/public/moduli/it/Direttiva_MinInterno_1-3-2000.pdf</a> ).
	Declaration regarding the availability of suitable accommodation in Italy, as well as the amount required for repatriation, which can also be proven by showing a return air ticket.
	Health/insurance coverage for medical treatment and hospital admissions, which shall not result in limitations or exceptions.
