	Valid travel document with an expiration date at least three months later than that of the requested visa.
	Round-trip reservation/ticket.
	Invitation letter accompanied by an identity document. (https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/files/public/moduli/it/DICHIARAZIONEALLOGGIOGARANZIA.PDF).
	Document proving family ties with the EU citizen (for example, a marriage certificate, a birth certificate, etc.)
	Evidence that will accompany or join the EU citizen in the EU host country, namely: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • proof that the EU citizen resides or is already present in the EU host country (for example, a valid registration certificate issued by the host country) • if the EU citizen is not yet present in the host country: a declaration stating that the EU citizen will travel to the destination country, a travel document for the same period, etc.

***FAMILY MEMBERS OF EUROPEAN UNION CITIZENS:**

1. **spouse, partner in a registered partnership** in one of the Member States, if equated to marriage by the host State,
2. direct **descendants** under 21 years of age or dependent** and those of the spouse/partner in a civil union; adopted children and minors under guardianship/permanent foster care with measures issued pursuant to Law 184/83 are also considered direct descendants.
3. **dependent** direct ascendants** and those of the spouse/partner in a civil union; among dependent direct ascendants is also included the foreign parent of an Italian/EU minor residing in Italy with the other parent

****DEPENDENT PERSON:**

Dependency must be proven through evidence of economic support provided by the inviting EU citizen.
