	Valid travel document with an expiration date at least three months later than that of the requested visa.
	Round-trip reservation/ticket .
	Health insurance covering a minimum of €30,000 for emergency hospitalisation and repatriation expenses, valid throughout the Schengen area

	Proof of possession, by the applicant , of the means of financial means of subsistence, in the amount required by the Directive of the Ministry of the Interior of 1.3.2000, at this link: https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/files/public/moduli/it/Direttiva_MinInterno_1-3-2000.pdf .
	Supporting documentation of applicant's socio-economic conditions :* a) Bank statement of the last 3 months of the current account where the salary is received, stamped by the bank; b) Copy of the credit/debit card and the related bank statement of the last 3 months (if not available, indicate how expenses will be covered during the trip). <u>Additionally:</u> 1. For public employees : declaration from the employer indicating the salary; 2. For private company employees : declaration from the employer indicating the salary and company registration certificate; 3. For self-employed entrepreneurs : business license, bank receipt of tax payment, certificate of discharge (if not available, indicate the reason). <u>Recommended</u> : photographs of one's business where the company name is visible.

* It must belong to the **visa applicant** and not to the inviter, exceptions are only for minors, adults up to 21 years old if students, and spouses. In this case, the documents can be from the parents or the spouse, to be proven with birth certificates, marriage certificates, university enrollment, etc.

Non-Mozambican citizens: foreign resident identification document (Documento de Identificação de Residente Estrangeiro - DIRE) or valid residence permit.

Minors: copy of the Mozambican Identity Card (Bilhete de identidade – B.I.) or Birth Certificate.

1. If the minor is traveling alone or with only one parent: the consent of the holder(s) of parental responsibility or legal guardian, with a signature notarized by a Notary, accompanied by a copy of the identity document.

2. If the parent with whom the minor is traveling is the sole holder of parental responsibility: documents justifying the absence of consent from the other parent (court judgment, death certificate, etc.).
